This application is for those who would like to participate in this Cornerstone's 2025 short-term mission experience in February 2025 (10 day trip over the February Break).

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Please submit all forms by September 1st, 2024.
- 2. Please review and complete the Mission Trip Application in its entirety before submitting.
- 3. Please read and sign the attached Code of Conduct and Liability Release Form and return with your application.
- 4. Please attach a copy of your passport, if you do not yet have a passport see the note below.
- 5. The total cost of the trip is approx. \$3,000 (\$2,300 of which will be fundraised). Upon acceptance to the team you will be required to make a \$700 deposit made out to Cornerstone Church. You can pay by cheque or by e-transfer (giving@cornerstoneyxe.ca). In the memo line please write the person's name going on the trip and Bolivia Missions Trip.

NOTES:

- 1. If you don't already have a passport, please submit a note with your application to confirm you have applied for one.
- 2. This is a mission trip application form and does not guarantee acceptance on the trip. Once your application has been reviewed, the mission trip leader will contact you regarding your participation on the trip. REQUIREMENTS:

TEAM PREPARATION COMMITMENT

As a member of the Mission Team you will be expected to commit to ALL the team preparation meetings and expectations, before and after the mission trip. Please be aware that the dates above are tentative and may change. We will do our best to give enough notice of any date changes.

We value team building, cultural orientation and debrief so you must make these times a priority.

FINANCES: The cost of this trip will be approx. \$3,000 per person, depending on travel costs which we won't know until we book the flights. You will be required to personally contribute \$700 of these costs up front (or more if you desire) with the other \$2300 being fund raised. As a team, we will raise prayer and finances from the church and individuals. Every team member is required to help with fund raising and sending out support letters as we work together to raise the funds. Training and support will be given for this. Funds cover orientation, travel, and expenses in country as well as project or ministry costs.

It is important to know that immunizations, passport fees, travel insurance and meals on travel days are personal expenses. Also any shortfalls in fundraising will be covered evenly by the individual members of the team.

FINANCIAL MEMO OF UNDERSTANDING:

- 1. I understand that I am responsible for raising the funds required for the trip. The money I raise covers travel, food, lodging, exit taxes, ministry expenses and on ground transportation. I am responsible for passport, souvenirs, immunizations, and food/drink while traveling to and from trip destination.
- 2. Financial donations made on my behalf are for the mission team and are not mine alone—they belong to God and have been given to our team in order to accomplish the mission and work of the church.
- 3. If, for some reason, I do not ultimately participate on the mission trip to which I have been accepted, I am responsible for any fees incurred as a result of my cancellation.
- 4. If I do not raise enough money to pay for my trip, I may not be able to go. Any money raised will be applied to the current trip or materials needed.
- 5. If I raise an amount of money that exceeds my needs, remaining money will be dispersed to other team members in need or used by our team to meet other financial needs associated with the mission trip.
- 6. If, for some reason, I do not participate on the mission trip to which I have been accepted, I understand that the monies donated to my trip cannot be refunded to me or to the donors.
- 7. All materials, including airline and other travel tickets, that have been purchased with donated funds cannot be transferred outside of the trip.
- 8. If any inappropriate behaviour and/or breaking of any team covenant policies occur, you may be sent home at your/your parent's and/or guardian's expense.
